



Turtle Beach Audio Advantage Micro II – Manual Driver Installaton – April, 2014

This folder includes a new signed driver available for the Micro II USB sound card. This new driver should give you AC3 Pass-Through for Dolby Digital and for DTS. The driver will need to be manually installed into your system. Here are manual installation instructions for the Micro II signed driver.


1. If you haven't already, please [download the Zip file](#) containing the signed Micro II driver. Unzip the Zip file to a new folder on your Windows Desktop. That folder should be named **micro2driver**. Insert the Micro II USB sound card in a USB port on your PC. We recommend that you do not connect your Micro II to a USB hub. Please connect it to a USB port on the computer.
2. Windows will auto-detect the device and install a generic USB Sound Device driver. We will be manually updating this driver to the Micro II driver.
3. Click **Start** and open the **Control Panel**.




4. In the Control Panel, click on **Hardware and Sound**. Then click on **Device Manager**.




5. In the Device Manager, click on the **Sound, video and game controllers**, then right-click on **USB Sound Device**. Click on **Update Driver Software...**




6. The Update Driver Software - USB Sound Device window opens. Click **Browse my computer for driver software**




7. In the next window, click Let me pick from a list of device drivers on my computer




8. In the next window, notice that the device you see is the generic USB Sound Device. We want to update that driver, so click **Have Disk...**




9. In the **Install from Disk** dialog that opens, click **Browse...**




10. Select the location of the **micro2driver** folder where you saved it. Then click **Open**.




11. You should see the contents of the **micro2driver** folder in the **Locate File** dialog. In the **File name:** field, you should see the file **Cm102.INF** highlighted. Click **Open** to install from that file.



12. In the **Install from Disk** dialog, in the field **Copy manufacturer's files from:**, you should see the location of the micro2driver folder. Now click **OK**.




13. Now the Update Driver Software - USB Sound Device dialog should show the **Audio Advantage Micro 2** in the **Model** field. Below that you should see **This driver has an Authenticode(tm) signature**. Click **Next** to continue.



14. Windows may tell you that **Installing this device driver is not recommended because Windows cannot verify that it is compatible with your hardware**. This driver is tested and signed, so please click **Yes** to continue.

15. In the next dialog (**Windows Security**), you will be asked **Would you like to install this device software?** Please check the box **Always trust software from "Voyetra Turtle Beach, Inc"** and then click **Install** to continue.



16. The driver will now install. When the installation is complete, you should see a dialog stating **Windows has successfully updated your driver software**. Make sure that the device listed is the **Audio Advantage Micro 2**. If that is correct, then you've installed the new driver for the Micro II. Click **Close**.

17. In the Device Manager, you should see that the listing for USB Sound Device has been replaced with Audio Advantage Micro 2. The installation is now complete, and your Micro II is now ready to use.
